Appointed Consul General in Chicago June of 2003, Eugenio Sgrò has a long history in diplomatic service. In 1985, he earned a Masters Degree in Economics from a university in Rome. He then joined the Diplomatic Service in 1987. After a training course, he became the General Directorate for Cooperation to Development, Southern African Desk, with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Rome. Three years, later, in 1990, he was appointed General Directorate for Cooperation to Development, Central American Desk. In 1991, he assumed the title Chief Officer of the Commercial Office of the Italian Embassy in Canberra. Soon he was promoted to first Secretary and then, in 1992, to Head. He remained in that position until 1995 when he became Consul in Berlin, and was promoted in 1997 to Consigliere di Legazione. In 1999, he became the General Directorate for Italians Abroad and Immigration Policies with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Rome. In 2003 he was promoted to Consigliere d'Ambasciata and, then Consul General in Chicago.
