> TUITION CHARGES:

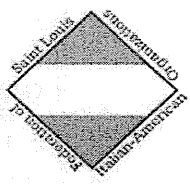
If you already have the required books, the tuition fee would be: \$90 (Adult course) and \$50 (Children course).

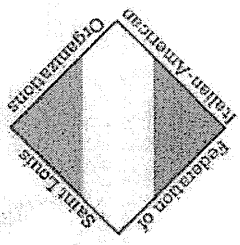

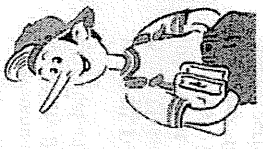

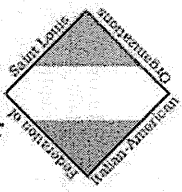
